- ★ In late 2008 we're launching a monthly roller disco event for children and families in Liverpool. There will be a roller disco DJ playing everything from roller disco classics to the latest tunes, over 600 pairs of roller skates from sizes 8 junior to 12 adult for hire, and a relaxing bar area for those tired legs. This will take place once a month on a Saturday evening at The Liverpool Guild of Students, 160 Mount Pleasant, Liverpool, L3 5TR. Please note, no alcohol will be served at this event.



COMPETITION

We want you to come up with a name and logo design for our monthly roller disco event, for example: "Rock 'n' Roller Disco". The logo design must contain the event name, but can also contain images and as many colours as you like. You can draw this by hand or use a computer.

The competition is open to anyone under the age of 18, who currently lives in Merseyside in the UK. The closing date for entries is 24 August 2008.

The winner will receive one brand new pair of inline skates OR quad roller skates, a protective equipment set, a t-shirt printed with their winning design, plus free entry for themselves and three friends or family members to the first event in 2008 (date to be confirmed). The 2 runners-up will each receive free entry for themselves and three friends or family members to the first event in 2008 (date to be confirmed).

ENTERING THE COMPETITION

1. The Roller Disco Logo Design Competition (the "Competition") is open to children living in Merseyside in the UK aged up to and including seventeen (17) years old ("You").

3. If hand drawing the logo, please send us 3 full colour copies of your completed design on A4 paper or card. You MUST also send us your completed application form.

If creating your design on the computer, please email your entry to info@superfunkrollerdisco.com along with the name of your Event, your Full Name, Age and Date of Birth, your Full Address including Postcode, Telephone Number, Email Address AND the Full Name and Telephone Number of your parent or guardian.

We accept the following formats: .bmp .eps .jpg .pdf .psd

The name of the event should not be longer than 5 words, and can include the words "roller" and "disco" if you so wish.

5. You can enter the Competition by posting your completed application form and three copies of your design to: Rollerstrut LLP, 41 Wellington Street, Preston, Lancashire, PR1 8TQ. Computer aided design entries should be emailed to: info@superfunkrollerdisco.com We will not consider application forms that We cannot read.
6. You are responsible for the cost of sending your Competition entry to us.
7. When sending in your Competition entry, You must provide your name, age, date of birth, address, telephone number and e-mail address (if You have one) and the name and contact telephone number of your parent or guardian. We will only use this information in relation to the Competition (including checking your eligibility to enter it and announcing the winners) and will not use it for any other purposes whatsoever. We will not keep this information for longer than is necessary for the operation of the Competition.
8. You may only send one entry to the Competition.
9. Your design must be your own work and must not be copied. If We have reason to believe your design is not your own work, then We may not consider it.
10. We must receive your entry to the Competition by 11:59 pm on Sunday 24 August 2008.

PICKING THE WINNERS

11. A panel of three judges (two from Rollerstrut LLP and one independent judge) will choose the winner and runners-up.
12. When choosing the winning entries, the judges will be looking for original eye-catching designs.
13. The judges' decision will be made on or before September 1 2008. The judges' decision is final.

PUBLISHING THE WINNING ENTRIES

14. The winning entry and runners-up entries will be published on the Superfunk Rollerdisco website at www.superfunkrollerdisco.com from September 2 2008 or (if Rollerstrut LLP needs to delay this publication for any reason) at a later date.
15. You own the copyright to your Competition entry as its designer.
16. By submitting an entry to the Competition, You give Rollerstrut LLP:
 - a. Permission for your entry to be published on the Superfunk Rollerdisco website and grant Rollerstrut LLP a non-exclusive, royalty-free, worldwide licence to republish your Competition entry in electronic format and hard copy for purposes connected with the Competition; and
 - b. The right to use your name, age and city of residence for the sole purpose of identifying You as the author of your entry.

GETTING CONSENT FROM AN ADULT

17. Sending in an entry to the Competition means that You accept these Terms and Conditions, which are the rules of the Competition. You should check with your parent or guardian that they are happy for You to enter the Competition based on these Terms and Conditions.
